

Grade 10 Three-Year Plans

The Student Services team at Western encourages all grade 10 students to book appointments with their counsellor to complete a three-year plan. The three-year plan is a working document that outlines the courses a student should take each school year to meet both graduation requirements and postsecondary goals. Questions regarding online and summer school options may be explored, too.

Students book counsellor appointments through Ms. Schwartz in the Student Services office. Usually, three-year plans are completed some time between October and February of a student's grade 10 year. (In March, students choose classes for the next school year.) Students book with their counsellor based on last name:
